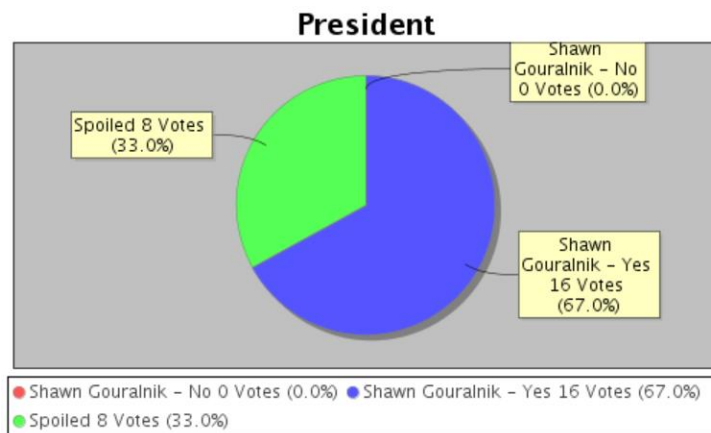


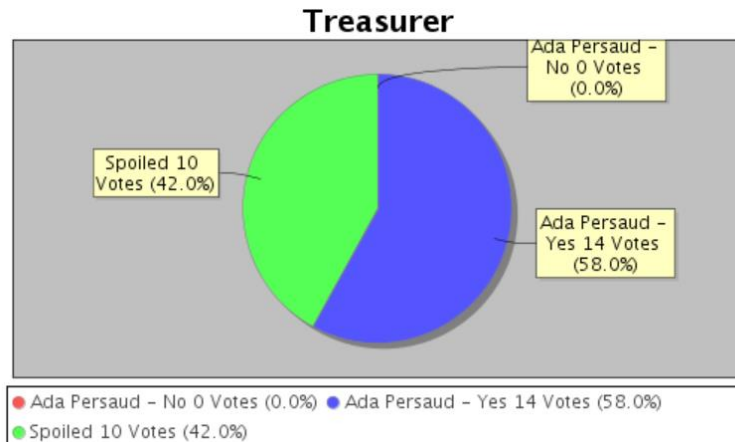


SCCR/Radio FWD Annual Election Results

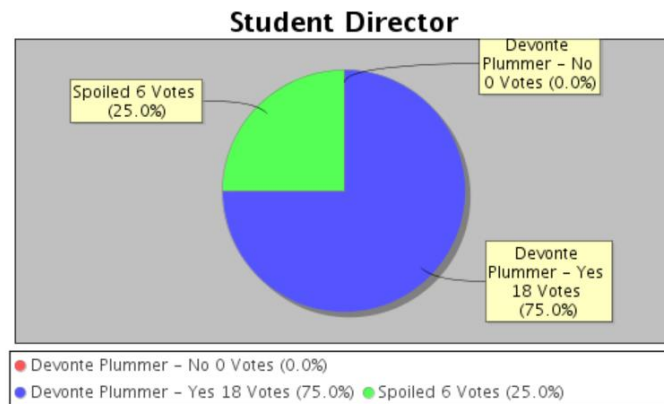
Voting was open from midnight of March 15, 2020, to March 16, 2020, at 11:59pm. The results are as follows:



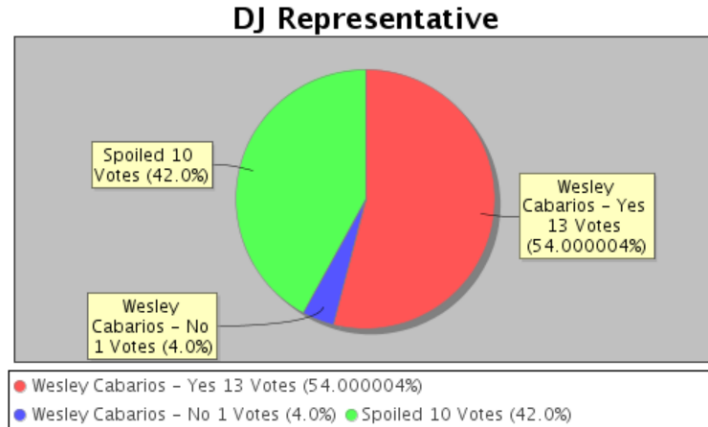
After two days of voting, Shawn Gouralnik was accepted for the role of President with a total of 16 votes (67%) voting yes for him as President, and 8 votes (33%) spoiled.



After two days of voting, Ada Persaud was accepted for the role of Treasurer with a total of 14 (58%) votes for yes, and 10 (42%) votes spoiled.



After two days of voting, Devonte Plummer was accepted for the role of Student Director with a total of 18 votes (75%) voting yes, and only 6 votes (25%) spoiled.



After two days of voting, Wesley Cabarios was accepted for the role of DJ Representative with a total of 13 votes (54%) voting yes, 1 vote (4%) voting no, and 10 votes (42%) spoiled.

Voting for the DJ Representative, which usually takes place separately from the other directors' positions, was processed through the UToronto online voting platform. According to SCCR policies and by-laws, the DJ Representative is voted in by current radio hosts. After great consideration, this adjustment to change those who are qualified to vote for the DJ

Representative was decided using my professional judgment to conduct a fair election, and after full review of SCCR policies and by-laws.

Given the status of Scarborough Campus Community Radio's rebranding, many radio hosts were still restarting their programming or haven't completed training. There were not enough established radio hosts to place votes for this position. There was 1 radio host, Wesley Cabarios, who was able to gather nominations to be elected for the position. The DJ Representative can be a fee-paying UTSC student or a fee-paying non-student community member, usually ONLY elected by radio hosts with no input from our general student membership. This means that only radio hosts vote for who represents them on the board. During this annual election period, it was difficult to elect a DJ Representative due to a very limited number of total radio hosts. In 2018, before Fusion Radio became Radio FWD, there was over 20 eligible radio hosts to vote. Now in 2020, there are hardly 3, and with the campus quarantine in place, all programming has completely stopped. There are no radio shows over the air at this current point in time.

After reviewing SCCR policies and discussion with current directors and staff, it was decided that the fairest way to choose a DJ representative at this time was to use the input of our general student membership via the UToronto election page. This year, Radio FWD's DJ representative was elected by fee-paying UTSC students via the University of Toronto's online voting platform (voting.utoronto.ca - signing in with student number), and our non-student membership was not able to cast a vote. The Radio FWD team hopes that future DJ Rep elections will have more participation from radio hosts, and hope that members understand the circumstances that resulted in these adjustments.
