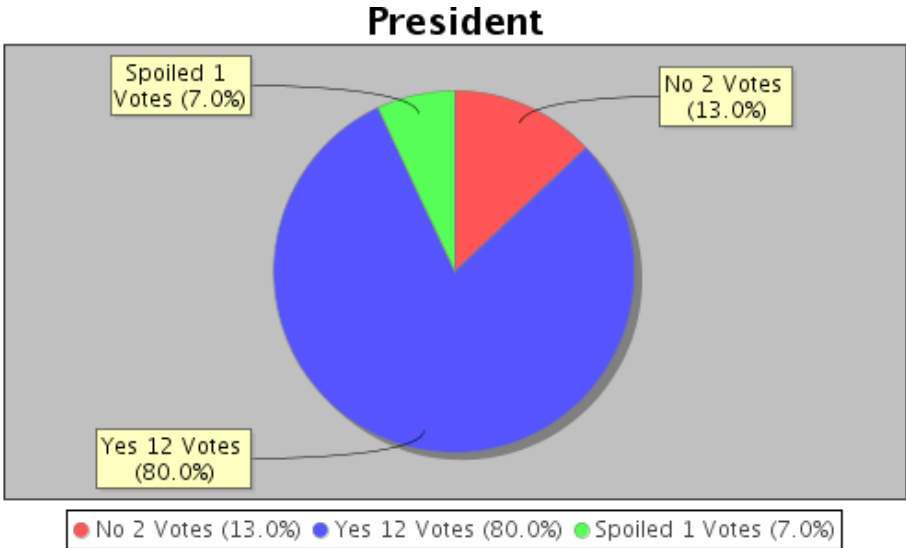




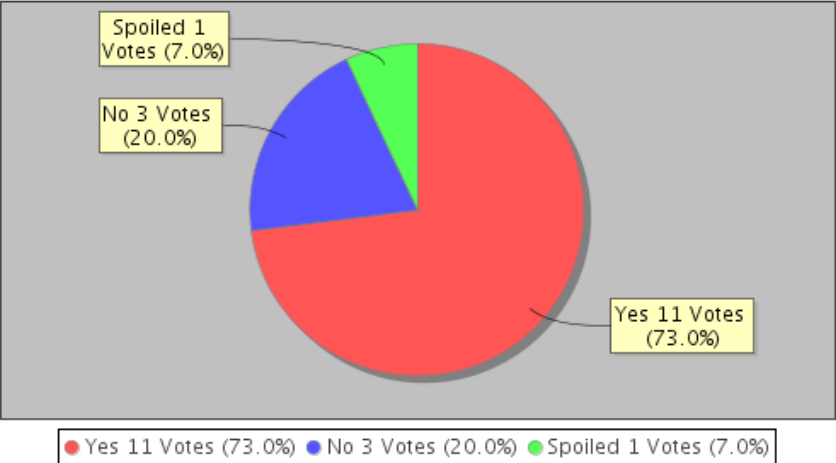
### SCCR/Radio FWD 2021-2022 Annual Spring Election Results

Voting was open from March 23, 2021 at 12:00am to March 24, 2021, at 11:59pm. A total of 15 votes were cast for this election from fee-paying students. All candidates ran unopposed in this election. The results are as follows:



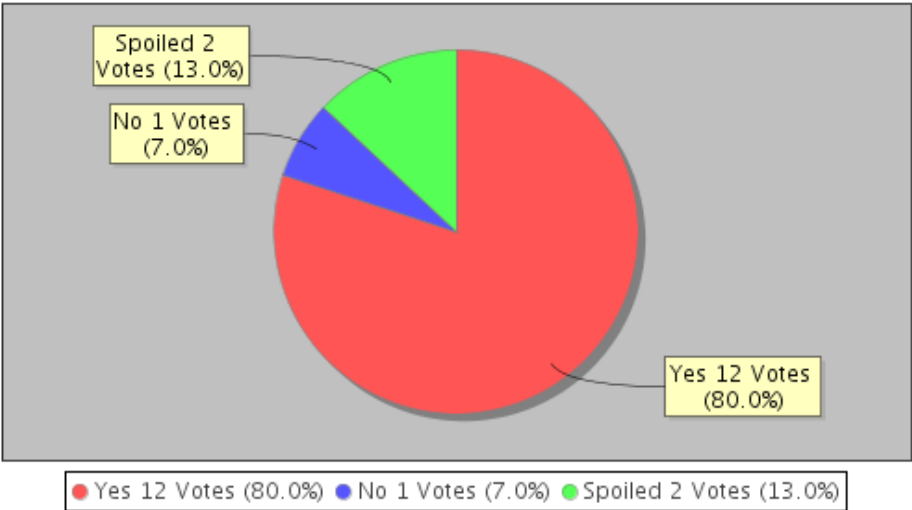
After two days of voting, Shawn Gournalnik was accepted for the role of President with a total of 12 votes (80%) voting yes, 2 votes (13%) voting no, and 1 vote (7%) spoiled.

### Vice President



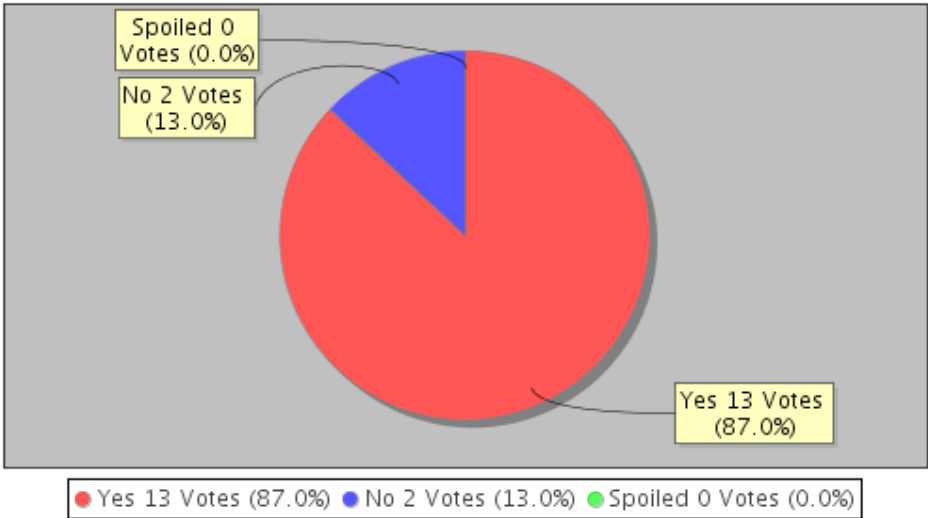
After two days of voting, Oluwapelumi Sobowale was accepted for the role of Vice President with a total of 11 votes (73%) voting yes, 3 votes (20%) voting no, and 1 vote (7%) spoiled.

### Treasurer



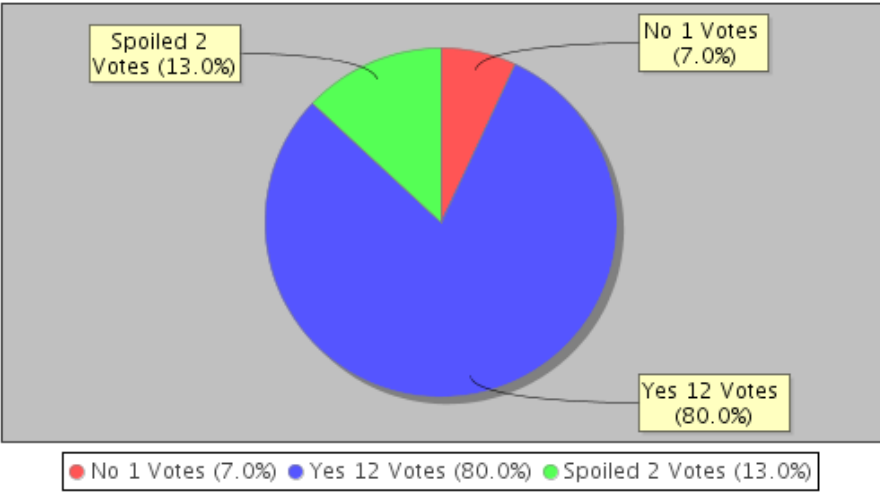
After two days of voting, Ada Persaud was accepted for the role of Treasurer with a total of 12 votes (80%) for yes, 1 vote (7%) for no, and 2 votes (13%) spoiled.

### Student Director 1

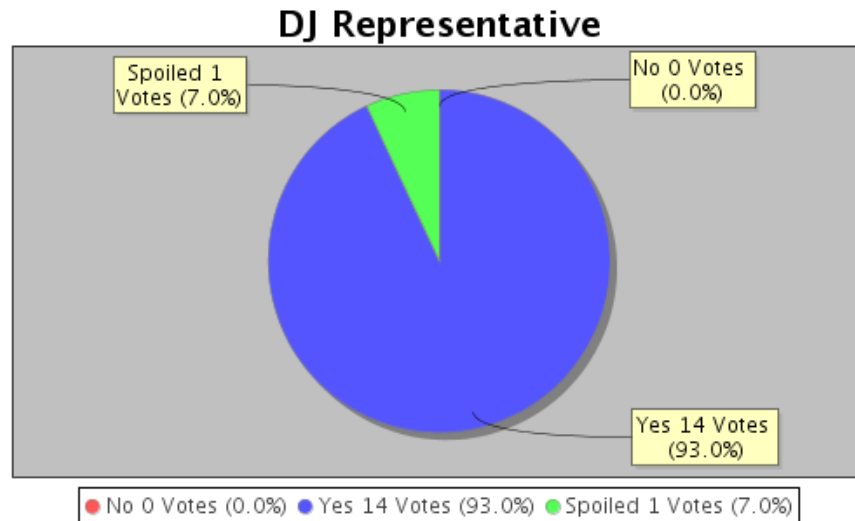


After two days of voting, Sofia Suleman was accepted for the role of Student Director 1 with a total of 13 votes (87%) voting yes, and 2 votes (13%) voting no.

### Student Director 2



After two days of voting, Devonte Plummer was accepted for the role of Student Director 2 with a total of 12 votes (80%) voting yes, 1 vote (7%) voting no, and 2 votes (13%) spoiled.



After two days of voting, Wesley Cabarios was accepted for the role of DJ Representative with a total of 14 votes (93%) voting yes and 1 vote (7%) spoiled.

Voting for the DJ Representative, which usually takes place separately from the other director positions, was processed through the UToronto online voting platform. According to SCCR policies and by-laws, the DJ Representative is voted in by current radio hosts. However, this adjustment to change those who are qualified to vote for the DJ Representative was decided using my professional judgment to conduct a fair election and after a full review of SCCR policies and by-laws.

The COVID-19 pandemic has created a shift in many aspects of university life. With the majority of classes taking place online, candidates were unable to collect nominations, campaign, or encourage their peers to vote on campus grounds. In addition, there are no active radio shows due to the campus quarantine. The DJ Representative can be a fee-paying UTSC student or a fee-paying non-student community member, usually ONLY elected by radio hosts with no input from our general student membership.

After reviewing SCCR policies and discussion with current directors and staff, it was decided that the fairest way to choose a DJ Representative at this time was to use the input of our general student membership via the UToronto election page. Similar to last year, Radio FWD's DJ Representative was elected by fee-paying UTSC students via the University of Toronto's online voting platform ([voting.utoronto.ca](https://voting.utoronto.ca) - signing in with UTORid) and our

non-student membership was not able to cast a vote. The Radio FWD team hopes that future DJ Representative elections will have more participation from radio hosts and kindly request that members understand the unprecedented situation which resulted in this alteration.
